Child Must Be

3 years old by September 1, for Pre-K3

4 years old by September 1, for Pre-K4

Requirements for Registration

- Child's official birth certificate
- Child's immunization record
- Parent or legal guardian's photo ID
- Proof of address (current utility, bill, lease, etc.)
- Three emergency contact numbers
- A **non-refundable** registration fee of **\$20 plus first month's tuition** (cash, check, money order, or credit card accepted)
- To see if you qualify for Title I reduced tuition bring your Income Tax Return from 2017 (1040 form) where your child's name is listed
- Accepting state scholarship vouchers from Workforce Services for **Pre-K4**

Pre-K4 - a.m. or p.m. Classes

3 hours per day – Mon -Thurs

Backman, Beacon Heights, Bennion, Dilworth (only p.m.), Edison, Escalante, Jackson (only a.m.), Liberty, Mountain View, Newman, North Star, Parkview, Riley (only a.m.), Washington, and Whittier Elementary Schools.

Pre-K4 - Full Day Classes

7 hours per day – Mon - Thurs

Franklin, Liberty, Meadowlark, and Mountain View Elementary Schools

To be considered for the **full day options** at Franklin, Liberty, Meadowlark, and Mountain View, families must reside within the school boundaries.

Pre-K3 - a.m. Classes

2.5 hours per day – Mon/Tues or Wed/Thurs

Dilworth, Liberty, Parkview, and Washington Elementary Schools.
