We understand this may be the first time you have registered at our school. The following information should help to prepare you for registration.

Please bring **3 current utility bills** to verify inbounds address. We also need to see the **original Birth Certificate and Immunization Record** and parent/guardian picture ID (we will make copies). Children must be 5 years old before September 1, 2018 to start school. ***If we have not received this documentation by the first day of class, your child cannot attend school.*** The following vaccines are required for all students: (<http://www.immunize-utah.org>)

5 DTP/DTaP/DT - 4 doses if 4th dose was given on/after the 4th birthday
4 Polio - 3 doses if 3rd dose was given on/after the 4th birthday
2 Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
3 Hepatitis B
2 Hepatitis A
2 Varicella (Chickenpox) - history of disease is acceptable, parent must sign verification statement on school immunization record.

Please check with your child's Pediatrician to verify immunizations.
