Pedestrian Safety: Weston Clark spoke about the request to extend the school zone to encompass the whole school. There is a huge problem with the parking, school crossing and pedestrian situation at Uintah. Westmoreland is an extremely dangerous situation. A parent meeting was brought up to inform parents, Bruce suggested it as part of rules assembly at the beginning of the year. Weston Clark spoke about trying to look at parking restrictions on each side of the street. Mid-block crosswalks are frowned upon so there is doubt that the city would look at moving our school crosswalk. Weston will take up the proposal of moving the crosswalk and doing parking restrictions on the sides of 1300 So. The gate on the 1500 E side of the field will be opened in the morning and afternoon to also help to spread out the traffic/pick-up spots. Weston suggested a map to be sent out to parents with drop-off/pick-up locations. Weston suggested a "warning sign" to warn commuters that they may want to take an alternate route because it is drop-off/pick-up time. Weston will gather information from the city and get it back to Amanda Funai for next year's meeting.
